

# Universally Accessible Facilities

## Plumas National Forest



### Welcome!

The Plumas National Forest welcomes visitors of varied abilities. The Beckwourth Ranger District has many opportunities offering universally accessible campsites, two trails, one boat launch, one fishing levy, three picnic areas and two interpretive sites. The Feather River Ranger District has one accessible fishing access ramp and trail at the Little Grass Valley Recreation Area. This guide will provide basic information for accessible campsites, trails, and other recreation facilities. ### Golden Access Passports

Golden Access Passports are honored in all campgrounds in the Plumas National Forest. Passports are free and available in person at any Forest Service office.

### Frenchman Lake Recreation Area

Located eight miles north of Chilcoot on County Road 284, Frenchman Lake is a high desert lake nestled in the pines. Fishing and boating are popular attractions. Supplies are available in Chilcoot. A trailer dump station is located by Cottonwood Springs Campground and has a \$5.00 fee.

### Big Cove Campground

This campground has 11 sites that are fully accessible with table, grill, fire ring, water spigot, a level hardened pad (two sites have a concrete pad) and path of travel to accessible toilet building.

- Elevation 5800 feet
- 38 units
- Reservations/first come-first serve
- \$18 Site Fee
- Water, Flush Toilets, trailer space

**Chilcoot Campground** has two fully accessible sites, with table, grill, fire rings, water spigot, a level hardened pad (one site has a concrete pad) and path of travel to accessible toilet building.

- Elevation 5,400 feet
- 40 units
- Reservations/first come first serve
- \$18 Site Fee
- Water, Flush Toilets, trailer space

**Cottonwood Group Camp** has loop B that can accommodate 25 people with accessible tables, grills, group fire rings and toilet building. This site is available by **reservation only**.

- \$70/25 persons

### Enabler Trail at Big Cove Campground

This paved trail is located at Big Cove campground. It is ¼ mile long and accesses Frenchman Lake.

### Frenchman Boat Launch

This four lane boat launch has an accessible loading ramp and toilet building. There is a \$5/auto day use Fee

**Frenchman Picnic Area** has one paved picnic site with accessible grills, tables, barbeque and path of travel to toilet building. There is a \$5 / auto day use fee.

### Portola Picnic Area

Located east of the town of Portola off highway 70, this picnic area is adjacent to the wild and scenic middle fork of the Feather River. A paved walkway provides access to an accessible picnic table, grill and fire ring on a paved platform. There are two interpretive signs and an accessible toilet building at this site.

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## Lake Davis Recreation Area

Located seven miles north of Portola on County Road 126, Lake Davis, at an elevation 5800 feet, is surrounded by mixed conifer forest with beautiful mountain views. The lake is well known for its great fishing opportunities. Supplies are available in Portola. A trailer dump station is located near Grizzly Campground for a \$5 fee.

## Lightning Tree Campground

This campground has eight fully accessible sites with asphalt pads.

- 40 Units
- Reservations / first come-first serve
- \$18 Single Site Fee
- \$36 Double Site Fee
- Water, Vault Toilets

## Grasshopper Flat Campground

This campground has two sites that are fully accessible with grills, fire rings, water spigot, paved pads and walkway to accessible toilet building.

- 70 units
- Reservations / first come-first serve
- \$18 Site fee
- Water, Flush toilets, trailer space

## Grizzly Campground

This campground has two sites that are fully accessible with grills, fire rings, water spigot, a hardened pad (one site is paved) and walkway to accessible toilet building.

- 55 units
- Reservations / first come-first serve
- \$18 Site fee water, flush toilets, trailer space

## Camp 5 Fishing Levy

This is a 100-foot levee that gives access to deeper water fishing.

- \$5/auto day use fee

## Honker Cove Boat Launch

An accessible restroom facility with flush toilets and showers. A fish cleaning station is also provided here.

## Lakes Basin Recreation Area

Located nine miles southwest of Graeagle on County Road 519, the Lakes Basin Area has special geological features and breathtaking scenery.

## Lakes Basin Petroglyphs

These are located adjacent to the campground and have a hardened path and platform to view petroglyphs and interpretive signs.

## Lakes Basin Campground

This campground has four sites that are fully accessible with grills, fire rings, water spigot, a level hardened pad and walkway to accessible toilet buildings.

- Elevation 6,400 feet
- 23 units
- Reservations / first come-first serve
- \$16 Single Site Fee
- \$32 Double Site Fee
- Water, Vault toilets, trailer space

## Frazier Falls Trail and Picnic Area

This is a ½ mile paved trail to Frazier Falls Overlook. This has an accessibility rating of difficult and assistance may be needed. The trailhead has an accessible picnic area with paved access to two tables and toilet buildings.

## Little Grass Valley Recreation Area

Little Grass Valley Reservoir has an accessible fishing ramp and restroom located on the south side of the dam. There is an accessible section of the trail paved between Running Deer campground and the Maidu Amphitheater.
