

2007 Request for Proposals

Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000 Shasta County Resource Advisory Committee

The Shasta County Resource Advisory Committee in cooperation with the USDA Forest Service is requesting proposals for the use of approximately \$300,000 provided by the Secure Rural Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000 (PL 106-393).

Funds can be used for projects on National Forest System lands and on adjacent non-National Forest System lands so long as the project benefits the adjoining National Forest.

Preference will be given to projects leverages funds or complements a larger project funded by other sources, provide employment opportunities to Shasta County residents and are of a short timeframe to implementation. Additionally, projects meeting three or more of the following criteria will be given additional consideration:

- Benefits rural communities in Shasta County
- Generates revenue and promotes economic benefit
- Creates an innovative or alternative industry/product
- Maximizes on the ground results
- Projects with a feasible timber element
- Benefit to fish and/or wildlife
- Increases tourism
- Minimizes overhead and administrative costs

Eligibility – Communities, schools, organizations, not-for-profits, associations and tribal and government agencies are eligible for funding. Proposals can be received up to the available amount. Project representatives should be available to present the merits of their project to the Resource Advisory Committee on September 13, 2007. Approved projects will require a combination of progress reports, presentations and/or site visits.

Applications are due September 5, 2007 by 4:30 p.m. Applications by email or CD are preferred, but not required.
