



<b>MAP LAYER LEGEND</b>	
<b>MAP LAYERS</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION OF THE LAYER</b>
<b>Analysis Unit Boundary</b>	Displays the dark gray outline boundary of all 10 analysis units.
<b>Analysis Unit Label</b>	Displays the labeling of the 10 analysis units.
<b>Analysis Unit Legend Map</b>	Displays the analysis unit maps on the legend.
<b>Background</b>	This layer can show up multiple times on the legend and displays the gray background and the gray inset background on the map.
<b>Background Feature</b>	Displays the campsites, trailheads, streams, forest boundary, wilderness, major reservoir, land status.
<b>Combined Use Roads</b>	Displays the highway legal roads, allowing non-highway legal use.
<b>Existing System No changes</b>	Displays no changes to the existing system.
<b>Labels</b>	Shows up multiple times and displays the following areas: Wilderness label, motorized use areas label, legend analysis unit label, highway symbols.
<b>Motorized Use Areas</b>	Displays the motorized use areas marker.
<b>Other</b>	There can be more than one " <i>Other</i> " layer followed by a number after it. Other displays several things including gray background, legend items, inset window, inset outline, north arrow, scale bar, table, and map border grid.
<b>Private, Commercial, Federal, or Special Uses Roads</b>	Displays other public and private roads not part of this process.
<b>Public Roads (State,County,City)</b>	Displays public roads not managed by the Forest Service and not part of this process.
<b>Quarter Quad Grid</b>	Displays a grid referencing the whole Forest by quarter quad.
<b>USGS Quarter Quad Name Label</b>	Displays the names of the old USGS quarter quad labeling system using common area names.
<b>USGS Quarter Quad Number Label</b>	Displays the names of the new USGS quarter quad labeling system.
<b>Roads Existing Changes</b>	Displays the changes to the existing roads system.
<b>Roads Label</b>	Displays the road numbers with season-of-use indicator.
<b>Roads Leader Line</b>	Displays the lines referencing to the roads label.
<b>Routes</b>	Displays the unauthorized routes added to the system.
<b>Routes Label</b>	Displays the route number with season-of-use indicator.
<b>Routes Leader Line</b>	Displays the lines referencing to routes label.
<b>Trails Existing Changes</b>	Displays the changes to the existing trail system.
<b>Vicinity Map</b>	Displays the Vicinity Map of the Sierra National Forest on the legend.
