

# WILDERNESS QUOTAS

## Sierra National Forest



From May until November, wilderness trailhead quotas are in place. For all trails, 60 percent of the trailhead quota is available through advanced reservations and 40 percent is available 24 hours prior to entry for walk-in visitors. Below is the trailhead name, the number of permits available for advanced reservations, and the number of permits available for walk-in pick-up.
