

Annual Summary of Services Provided by Commercial Pack Stock Permit Holders For the John Muir and Ansel Adams Wildernesses

Listed is a summary of the services provided by the 19 commercial pack stock permit holders for the Ansel Adams and John Muir Wildernesses. Services are recorded on tally sheets, including for each overnight trip, permit number, service start and end dates, entry and exit trail heads, number of clients, number of overnight employees, number of riding pack stock, type of trip, campsite or drop-off/pick-up spot used, number of service days in a National Park.
