


Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) has applied for a permit from the US Forest Service to conduct a geotechnical analysis and install temporary (up to 3 years) groundwater monitoring wells. They have requested to install these wells in order to collect more data for a potential realignment of SR 14. Wells would be 3” in diameter and go down to a depth of up to 100 feet. They would extend up to 3’ above ground, and be located in 3 locations on National Forest System Lands. WSDOT would monitor the wells once a month.

The location of the project is Section 16 T1N, R5E WM, Lots: 300 & 400. The project is located in the Forest and Agriculture Land Use Designations in the Revised CRGNSA Management Plan and will be reviewed under expedited review due to the size and use of the structures and the location in the Forest and Agriculture land use designations.
