Commercial Road Rules

During the "Big Game" hunting season, ALL VEHICLES entering roads normally closed to the public within the sale area, are prohibited from carrying bows or firearms. Vehicles are also prohibited from transporting hunters and/or game animals into or out of the closed area.

Closure devices are to be kept closed and locked during periods of non-use including evenings and weekends. All entrances into closed areas will be clearly signed "For Logging Use Only" during periods of active operations.

Purchaser is responsible to ensure that no "Lock-Ins" occur when closing and locking gates and barricades at the end of the day.

All Hauling is Prohibited on weekends.

All operations are prohibited from 6 P. M. Friday to 2 A.M. Tuesday during the Memorial Day and Labor Day holidays and from 6 P.M. on July 2nd to 2 A..M. July 6th.

Operations can be conducted from December 1 through March 31 but operations are limited to either the west or east of the BPA right of way at one time with unit 44 being included with the west side.

If operations are occurring east of the BPA right of way after December 1st, then no operations shall be approved on the west side until the next summer operating season. Only one side of the sale may be operated each winter after December 1st.
