<u>FELLING METHODS</u>	<u>PAYMENT UNITS</u>
Trees shall be directionally felled away from riparian areas and stream courses designated on the Sale Area Map.	All
No falling is authorized within protected areas unless agreed to in writing.	All
Bucking of butt logs may be required for protection of residual stand if damage is occurring from yarding or skidding operations.	All
Hand felling required, unless otherwise agreed to in writing.	Units designated 'H' and "S" on Sale Area Map.

<u>FELLING EQUIPMENT</u>	<u>PAYMENT UNITS</u>
Mechanical felling equipment will not exceed 12 feet in width.	All
Mechanical felling equipment will be restricted to designated trails. Equipment will not be allowed off these trails unless otherwise agreed to in writing	All
Mechanical felling equipment must be equipped with an excavator-type articulating arm with a minimum external reach of at least 20 feet	All
Except for manually felled trees which exceed the processor's capability, Included Timber shall be felled, limbed, bucked, and prebunched by a self-propelled mechanical processor. The processor shall place unmerchantable tops and limbs evenly in the forwarder road as it proceeds.	Payment Units designated "CTL" on the Sale Area Map
