

Notes to User

Except for dead trees meeting A2 specifications only those dead trees needed to meet Washington State Safety Code and Specified Road Requirements will be required to be felled BT2.32, and BT2.35.

All skid trails to be located and approved prior to felling in all Payment Units.

Treatment of landing, skid trail and temporary road construction slash is required on the sale area.

All tractor land and skid trails for the first 150 feet in length converging to a landing and temporary roads construction by the Purchaser must be ripped to 4 inches after use.

All skid trails and landings will be scarified and seeded where designated by the Forest Service.

Tree length logging is prohibited in units 12 and 13.

Purchaser to clean equipment prior to moving on to the Sale Area and arrange an inspection by the Forest Service. BT6.35

All landings will be piled. CT6.74
