The Forest Service will receive sealed and oral bids in public at Colville National Forest, Supervisor's Office at 10:00 AM local time on 09/25/2008 for an estimated volume of 8780 CCF of Douglas-fir & Western Larch sawtimber, and 2878 CCF of Lodgepole Pine & Other Coniferous Species sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Mixed Conifer Species non-saw that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$128,391.88. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads. Additional information concerning this option is in the prospectus. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
