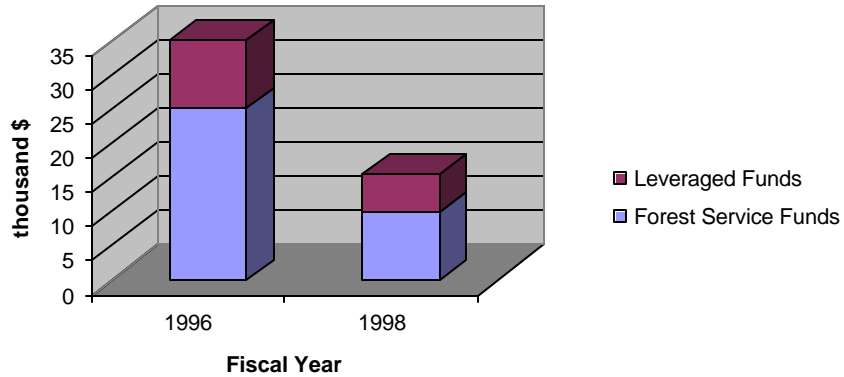
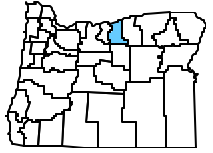




# Economic Action Programs Gilliam County, Oregon

Gilliam County is a nonmetropolitan county located in north-central Oregon on the Columbia Plateau. About two-thirds of the county's population lives in two major communities, Arlington and Condon, and the remaining one-third live in unincorporated areas. Nearly a quarter of Gilliam County's workforce is in farming, forestry, and fishing occupations. The agriculture sector, the largest in the state as a percentage of employment, provides over one half of all jobs. Government enterprises employment is the largest in the state, proportionally, due primarily to the sanitary landfill operations. Nearly all land area is in farms. There is very little federal land or private timberland and negligible timber harvest.
