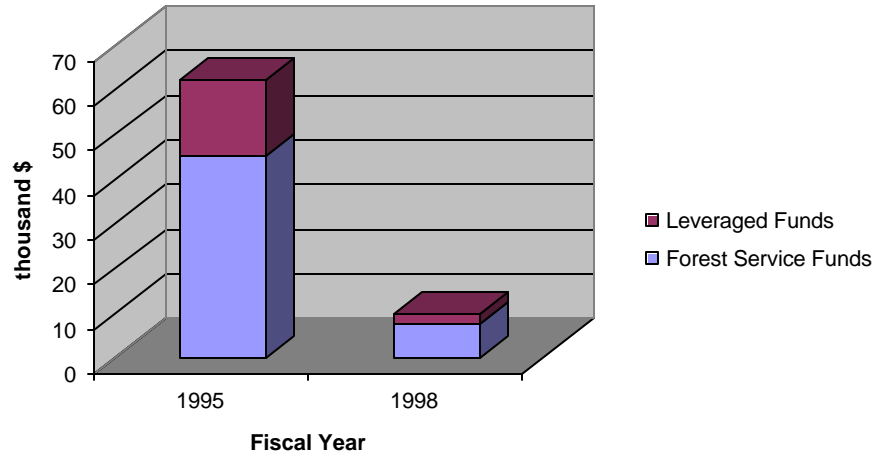
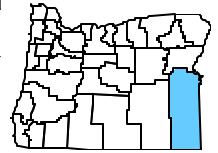




Economic Action Programs Malheur County, Oregon

Malheur County is a nonmetropolitan county located in the southeast corner of the state. The 2nd largest county in the state, about 70% of the land area is administered by the Bureau of Land Management which includes the Wild and Scenic Owyhee River. Only about 4,000 of the over 6 million acres in the county are administered by the Forest Service. About 20% of the county is farmland. County residents are primarily employed in the ranching and livestock industries, food processing, and federal government.
