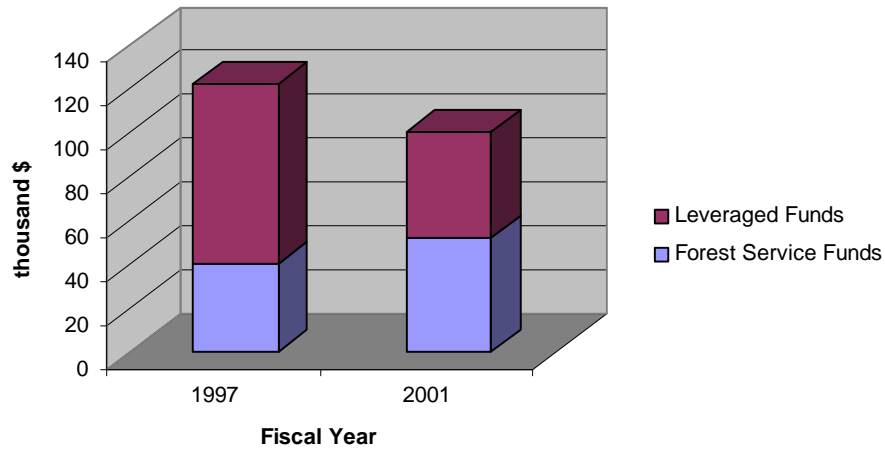




Economic Action Programs Spokane County, Washington

Spokane County is a metropolitan county located in the northeastern part of the state and bounded by Idaho on the east. It derives its name from the Spokane Indians, meaning “child of the sun”. The county’s first permanent settlements were established in the 1870s and the county’s prosperity was assured with the arrival of the Northern Pacific Railroad in 1890. Today the county has a varied economy based on manufacturing and agriculture. Spokane, the county seat and second largest city in the state, is a regional transportation, financial and cultural center.
