

INTERAGENCY AVIATION OPERATIONS AGREEMENT
FOR OKANOGAN B AND C AND ROOSEVELT B
MILITARY OPERATIONS AREA

1. Introduction. This operating agreement prescribes the procedure to cancel, recall or coordinate military training flight operations below 9000 feet MSL within the boundaries of the Okanogan and Roosevelt Military Operations Areas (MOAs) with an overall objective to enhance safe aviation activities.

2. Cancellation. This agreement supersedes and cancels the Interagency Aviation Operations Agreement for Okanogan B and C and Roosevelt B Military Operations Areas dated April 1988.

3. Scope.

a. This operating agreement applies to all NAS Whidbey Island and Northwest Air Defense Sector assigned forces and to other Department of Defense units which may schedule, coordinate or control training flights within the above described MOAs below 9000' MSL. This operating agreement is provided as information to Seattle ARTCC.

b. All signatories to this agreement shall ensure procedures set forth are enforced. Cancellation/modification is authorized with mutual consent of all parties; however, it is understood that such action shall not take place during the peak fire season from 1 April to 1 November. Land Management Agencies participating in this agreement are: Washington State Department of Natural Resources, Northeast Region; U.S. Forest Service Colville, Okanogan, and Wenatchee National Forests; and Bureau of Indian Affairs, Colville Agency.

4. Responsibilities.

a. Land Management Agencies (responsible agency dispatch):

(1) Upon initiating aviation activities that may conflict within active scheduled MOAs, call NAS Whidbey Island Range Schedules Division and inform them of the specific location (RAD/DME, LAT/LONG) and type of aviation activity taking place to include aircraft staging/departure points.

(2) For incidents requiring multiple aircraft operations, request an FAA Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR) under FAR 91.137 as guided by the Interagency Airspace Coordination Guide and comply with (1) above.

(3) Upon completion of aviation activities, promptly notify NAS Whidby Island Range Schedules Division.

b. Okanogan National Forest Dispatch: act as single point of contact for NAS Whidbey Island Range Schedules Division and notify remaining land management agencies concerning Okanogan B and C, and Roosevelt B MOA schedule.

c. NAS Whidbey Island Range Schedules Division:

(1) Provide a usage schedule for Okanogan B and C, and Roosevelt B MOAs to Okanogan Dispatch prior to the day they occur between April 1 and November 1.

(2) Upon notification from a land management agency that a Temporary Flight Restriction (FAR 91.137) has been requested, or that an occurrence resulting in air activities is taking place, recoordinate/recall/cancel military flying operation in the affected MOA and ensure it remains clear until notified that activities are complete.

d. NW AD Sector Operations Control Center Senior Director:

(1) Recoordinate/recall/cancel flying operations under AD Sector control operating in the MOA as directed by NAS Whidbey Island.

(2) Notify NW AD Sector schedulers of land management aviation activities and location. Provide updates as necessary.

(3) Notify appropriate Air National Guard Tactical Air Control Units of aviation activity and location. Provide updates as necessary.
