**A. Project Description**

Lakeview District Ranger, Terry Sodorff, proposes to remove existing Forest road #3915-152 from the National Forest Road System and recommend that a Private Road Easement be granted for the continued use and maintenance (by the private land owner).

**B. Location**

National Forest System Road #3915-152 on the Lakeview Ranger District at: T. 40 S., R. 22 E., W.M., section 20.

**C. Existing Conditions and Desired Condition**

After a land exchange was completed with the Forest Service in the 1950's, the private landowners built the subject road to access their private property. At some point, the Forest Service entered the road into their National Forest Road System. Road mainenance (road surface; ditch lines; drainage structures, ect.) has been provided by the private landowner since the road was constructed. Continuing access to Ward and Polander Creeks would be from the 3915-023 road.

**D. Purpose and Need For Action**

The underlying need is for private land owner access and maintenance of existing road.

**E. Decision to be Made**

Should Forest road #3915-152 be removed from the National Forest Road System and the proposed Private Road Easement be granted, or should any modifications be made to the proposed action based on comments received?

Are there extraordinary circumstances that warrant further analysis and documentation in an EA or EIS?

Is the action consistent with the management direction of the FLRMP or is a site-specific Forest Plan amendment necessary?

F. **Initial Issues:**

Internal scoping for this project will be provided for and documented by routing of a project card. Fremont South Zone (Bly and Lakeview Ranger Districts) resource specialists will document remarks and/or reports as necessary to provide adequate information and analysis.
