Mount Baker-Snoqualmie National Forest Monitoring Summary Form

DISTRICT: Mount Baker Ranger District

PROJECT NAME: Baker Blowdown Salvage

MONITORING OBJECTIVE: Assess the effectiveness of mitigation measure regarding discovery of previously unidentified archaeological or historic resource discovery.

MONITORING TYPE: Effectiveness

PRIORITY: Moderate.

PARAMETER: Number of previously unidentified archaeological or historic resource sites that are not detected during harvesting activities.

METHODOLOGY: Implement surveys in high probability units where surveys could not be conducted prior to harvest due to high levels of blowdown. Survey methodology will follow the Forest's Cultural Resource Inventory Strategy (Hearne and Hollenbeck, 1996).

FREQUENCY/DURATION: Once, within 6 months of harvest.

DATA STORAGE: SO Heritage Resource Files

REPORT: Once, within 12 months of harvest.

PROJECTED COSTS: One GS-7 surveying for 4 days @ \$278/day = \$1,112 and One GS-12 for 1 day @ \$428/day = \$1,540.
