Training Announcement S-190 Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior S-130 Firefighting Training (Includes L-180 Human Factors in the Wildland Fire Service)

Nominations due MARCH 25, 2011

Minimum number of students: 15

Maximum number of students: 30

S-190 Description: This course provides instruction in the primary factors affecting the start and spread of wildfire and recognition of potentially hazardous situations.

S-190 Objectives:

- Identify and discuss the three sides of the fire triangle.
- Identify the environmental factors of fuels, weather and topography that affect the start and spread of wildland fire.
- Describe the contributing factors that indicate the potential for increased fire behavior that may compromise safety.

S-130 (L-180) Description: This course is designed to provide entry level firefighter skills.

S-130 (L-180) Objectives:

- Explain what the LCES system is and how it relates to the Standard Firefighting Orders.
- Construct fireline to required standards using various methods.
- Strengthen, reinforce, and use holding action on a fireline.
- Extinguish the fire with or without the use of water.
- Complete assigned tasks in a safe and efficient manner.
- Given an assignment in a wildfire environment, describe factors in that environment which could impact safety.
