This course is designed to meet the training needs of the incident commander type 4. It is presented in a discussion/exercise format. The six instructional units include Foundation Skills; Intelligence Gathering and Documentation; Size Up the Incident; Develop a Plan of Action; Post-fire Activities; Evaluating Incident Objectives and Manage the Incident. Evaluation of the student is by unit test and performance based evaluations.

TARGET GROUP: Personnel desiring to be qualified as an incident commander type 4 (ICT4).
