COURSE DESCRIPTION: The course is designed to meet the training needs of the incident commander type 3 (ICT3). The focus is on the lessons of leadership and command as they relate to the ICT3 position. It is presented in a participative lecture format with multiple tactical decision games for students to practice new knowledge.

OBJECTIVES: 1) Demonstrate an understanding of the concept of Command as it relates to the ICT3. 2) Demonstrate effective foundation skills at the ICT3 level. 3) Develop situational awareness of incident environment. 4) Demonstrate effective command and control over a quickly assembled team in a time constrained and rapidly changing incident environment. 5) Demonstrate the ability to manage an incident. 6) Conduct post fire activities
