This is a correction regarding the scoping letter for the South Fork Skokomish Large Wood Enhancement Project, dated February 2, 2009. In the description of the Proposed Action it states "Trees ranging from 12 to 24 inches in diameter would be removed from up to 250 acres of second-growth forest stands in the South Fork and North Fork subwatersheds." it should read "Trees ranging from 12 to 30 inches in diameter" There are trees in the Adaptive Management Area (AMA) stands which are 30 inches in diameter that may potentially be used in the construction of the large wood structures. Any removal of these trees would follow Forest Plan standards and guidelines, and meet AMA goals and objectives.
