### Interrorem Cabin



**ACCESS:** Travel 22 miles north of Hoodport on US Highway 101 to the Duckabush Recreation Area F.S. Rd. 2510. Turn west and follow the Duckabush Road for 4 miles to the end of the pavement. Interrorem Cabin is on the left side of the road just inside the Olympic National Forest boundary.

**SEASON AVAILABLE:** Year around.

**AREA ATTRACTIONS:** Hood Canal, The Brothers Wilderness, and Olympic National Park. Excellent short family day hikes from cabin, fishing, bird watching, wildlife viewing, and rain forest atmosphere.



**SITE HISTORY:** This single-story, square, peeled-log cabin has an open porch across its facade and a pyramidal cedar shake roof. Built in 1907 as the first administrative building on the Olympic National Forest, which, at the time, included the area that is now Olympic National Park. Emery J. Finch, Ranger and Hoodport pioneer, built the cabin and first occupied it with his new bride on April 22, 1908. Between the years 1933 to 1942, the station hosted several government programs such as the Emergency Relief Administration, Works Progress Administration and the Civilian Conservation Corps. From 1942 to 1986 the cabin served as a fireguard station. From 1986 to 1994, it was used by F.S. volunteers, and from 1994 to present it has been available to the public through a cabin rental program.

**CABIN FACILITIES:** Historic 24' X 20' log cabin with kitchen, living room and small bedroom. No electricity. Propane heater, cook range, refrigerator, and lights. Propane is furnished. Potable water is available, outside the fence, from a hand pump well. An outdoor vault toilet is a short distance from the back of the cabin.

**A NW Forest Pass or a Golden Passport is needed to park at the trailhead next to the cabin. When renting the cabin, park your vehicle inside the fence.**

**SITE FACILITIES:** Parking lot, trailhead to Ranger Hole Trail #824 and Interrorem Nature Trail #804, small picnic area, and vault toilet.

**CABIN RENTAL FEE/CAPACITY:** \$50.00 a night plus reservation fee. 4 people maximum. No pets.
