Reducing fuel loading in these areas will provide for a much safer area for recreationists and should a fire occur in this area, control would be much safer and easier for all involved. 9a. Project Cost: \$12,800

10. Project Description: (max. 30 lines.) Fuels will be treated by mechanical means, burning, and hand slashing, or a combination of one or more of these methods. Treatment has already begun in some of these areas and follow-up work is needed. This is one of the highest visited areas by recreationist on the Dunes and will be done adjacent to the following recreation developments (Umpqua Lighthouse State Park, Umpqua Beach parking lots 1 and 2, and Umpqua Beach Road). We plan to create buffers and fuel breaks to allow for safer and timely fire management.
