Statement of Project Goals and Objectives: (max. 7 lines) Lane County will install culverts that will be designed to improve fish passage for all life stages of anadromous and resident fish and other aquatic species. The new culverts will be designed to maintain structural integrity for a 100-year flow. In mid-1996, the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife entered into a contract, which committed ODFW to inventory, assess and prioritize for repair, all culverts associated with county-owned roadways where salmonids are present. The culverts for this project were found to block fish passage and were ranked as "High" priority for replacement. The reason they received high priorities was due to the amount of high quality habitat that was being denied to salmonids above the culvert.</p> <p>9a. Project Cost: \$46,292</p>
