Statement of Project Goals and Objectives: (max. 7 lines)</p> <p>Complete priority projects on Federal lands requiring hand labor while providing meaningful work for the Community Service Forest Work Camp (FWC). Federal lands in Lane County have large backlogs of needs that FWC crews can address. Expand the FWC from 30 to 95 beds this year and to 120 beds next year. The Lane County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) is using General and Title III Funds for FWC staff and is seeking Title II funds to provide provide transportation, food, medical services, equipment, other materials and supplies and Federal agency coordination and monitoring. Without these Title II funds, the FWC can not be expanded.</p> <p>9a. Project Cost: \$95,735</p>

<p>10. Project Description: (max. 30 lines.)</p> <p>FWC crews are currently working on Federal lands. This program will expand significantly. Federal land managers from Lane County have identified projects that require full time work for 8 to 15 crews each year. Projects include forest health improvement, habitat restoration, riparian release, control of noxious weeds, refuse removal, trail maintenance, road maintenance and decommissioning, camp ground maintenance, and wildfire hazard reduction. For FY-02, the FWC will provide four to six 10-inmate crews to work on Federal lands. The Forest Service will coordinate the work to ensure that crews are focused on the highest priority sites, to assure permits and environmental documentation are secured, and monitor the work. Lane County Sheriff's Office intends to expand the FWC to 120 beds in LCFY-03 for approx. \$4.3 million and provide eight crews to work on Federal lands. A prorata share of the FWC Title II expenses are allocated to all four Forest Service/BLM units in Lane Co in Title II applications.</p>
