Statement of Project Goals and Objectives: Contain and control the spread of Gorse in Western Lane County with specific objectives of: * Restore and enhance native plant communities and wildlife habitats degraded by gorse infestations. * Reduce the threat of wildfires by reducing dense gorse fuels. * Increase the quality of dispersed recreation in gorse infested areas.</p> <p>9a. Project Cost: \$37,780</p>

<p>10. Project Description: (Provide concise description of project and attach map.) Control of gorse in Western Lane County has been identified as high priority weed control project on the forest. An Environmental Assessment was completed for this project in 1997. The project involves implementation of an integrated vegetation management plan (IVMP) to control gorse in Western Lane County. The IVMP will treat gorse colonies using a variety of methods including manual removal, biological controls, mechanical treatments and herbicides according to site-specific conditions. Public education, monitoring and cooperative control efforts across jurisdictional and land ownership boundaries are included as an integral part of the IVMP. Although a number of project activities have been completed full implementation has not been possible due constraints in funding.</p>
