Statement of Project Goals and Objectives: (max. 7 lines) Reduce the hazardous fuels on lands bordering high-use recreation areas in the Siltcoos Recreation area to provide a fuel break around recreation facilities. Reducing fuel loading in these areas will provide a much safer area for recreational use should a fire occur in this area. Fuel breaks will allow fire agencies control points to protect both facilities and the public.</p> <p>9a. Project Cost: \$12,595</p>

<p>10. Project Description: (max. 30 lines.) Fuels will be treated by mechanical means, burning, and hand slashing, or a combination of one or more of these methods. Treatment has already begun in some of these areas and follow-up work is needed. This is one of the highest visited areas by recreationist on the Dunes and will be done adjacent to the following recreation developments (Driftwood II Campground, Siltcoos Beach public parking area and along the beach. We plan to create buffers and fuel breaks to allow for safer and timely fire management.</p>
