9. Statement of Project Goals and Objectives: Prep., plan and maintain riparian sites on Moon Creek.
9a. Project Cost: \$5,720

10. Project Description: (Provide concise description of project and attach map.) Prepare the sites along Moon Creek. Plant conifer seedlings on the prepared sites, and protect the seedlings from shrub competition and animal damage. Animal damage protection measures include installation and maintenance of protective tubes and trapping of mountain beaver (trapping temporarily reduces the population in the immediate vicinity of the site, but populations in these areas are large and quickly repopulate the site after seedlings are established). Site preparation and protecting the seedling from shrub competition involves contract crews using chainsaws to cut competing shrubs and hardwoods from around the seedling-planting site, allowing the seedling to obtain sufficient light, water, and nutrients while the seedling struggles to become established.
