Celebrate National Fishing Week on the Umatilla National Forest Four Free Kid's Fishing Derbies Scheduled

Four free fishing derbies are planned on the Umatilla National Forest in celebration of National Fishing Week, so grab your kids and head out to one of the sponsored events! Fishing instruction, games, snacks, prizes and environmental education activities make each event a day of fun and discovery for children and adults alike.

National Fishing week is an annual celebration designed to increase public awareness of the joys of recreational fishing and conservation of our fisheries resource. Free fishing days, Saturday and Sunday, June 6 and 7, are offered by the states of Oregon and Washington and set the stage for the variety of organized events in the area. Children participating in these events will need to bring their own fishing gear and must be accompanied by an adult.

TWIN PONDS - NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RANGER DISTRICT (UKIAH, OREGON)

The North Fork John Day Ranger District is sponsoring a “Kid’s Fishing Derby” Saturday, June 6, at Twin Ponds, located 6 miles south of Ukiah on Forest Road 52 (follow signs from Ukiah). The Fishing Derby will take place from 7:30AM to noon. Food and drinks are provided for everyone who registers and participates in the Derby.

Fishing derby T-shirts will be sold for \$12 each. All proceeds go to purchase prizes for next year’s event. Environmental education activities, a “biggest fish” contest and a casting contest will also be held. Prizes will be awarded for four age categories. WILLOW CREEK RESERVOIR - HEPNER RANGER DISTRICT (HEPNER, OREGON)

The Kid's Fishing Derby at Willow Creek Reservoir will be held on Sunday, June 7, from 1:00-4:00 PM. Registration is from 12:00-1:00 PM. The event is sponsored by the Heppner Lions Club, Mid Columbia Bass Club, Northwest Steelheaders, High Desert Marine, Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, and the USDA Forest Service.

Youngsters 12 years or younger can register the day of the derby. Children must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, and should bring their own fishing poles and tackle.

Environmental education activities and a casting contest will be held. Prizes, donated by local merchants and clubs, will be awarded.

WEST EVANS POND AND RAINBOW LAKE - POMEROY RANGER DISTRICT (POMEROY, WASHINGTON)

The Pomeroy Ranger District, in cooperation with the Asotin County Sportsmen, are sponsoring two free fishing activities. The first Free Fishing Derby will be held Saturday, June 6, at West Evans Pond, located two miles west on Highway 12 out of Clarkston, Washington.

The second Free Fishing Derby will be held Sunday, June 7, at Rainbow Lake, located adjacent to the Tucannon Fish Hatchery along the Tucannon River (Forest Road 47.) Registration for both events will begin at 8:00 AM and are open for all children 14-years old and younger.

Prizes will be awarded at both derbies for the “smallest” and “biggest” fish caught. There will also be raffle drawings for prizes at the end of the event around noon.
