****Forest Road 47 (Tucannon River Road) Closed south of junction with Forest Road 4620 to the end of the road at Meadow Creek Trailhead, July 29 to mid to late August**

Beginning July 29, Eastern Oregon Environmental Recovery, based out of Pendleton, OR will replace a culvert on Forest Road 47 which will close the road just south of its junction with Forest Road 4620. ****The closure will also prevent access to Panjab and Ladybug Campgrounds, and Panjab, Meadow Creek and Tucannon Trailheads.** This project was made possible through partnerships with the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife, the Governor's Salmon Recovery Office, and the Tri-State Steelheaders Fisheries Enhancement Group, Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation. The Pomeroy Ranger District, the northern-most District of the Umatilla National Forest is located in southeastern Washington and northeastern Oregon within the Blue Mountains. Over 177,000 acres are located within the Wenaha-Tucannon Wilderness. The Wilderness is characterized by rugged basaltic ridges and outcroppings separated by deep canyons with steep side slopes. Just a reminder: Starting the spring of 2009, the Northwest Forest Pass will be required at designated trailheads. These are good at any fee-demo trailhead in Oregon and Washington.
