Take US 27 south from the Stearns District Office for 4.7 miles to KY 92. Turn right, go 1.2 miles then turn right on KY 92 at Fastway Store. Go 5.3 miles to KY 1363, turn left and go 11.4 miles to the end of blacktop. Turn left, go 0.2 mile. Camp is on the left.

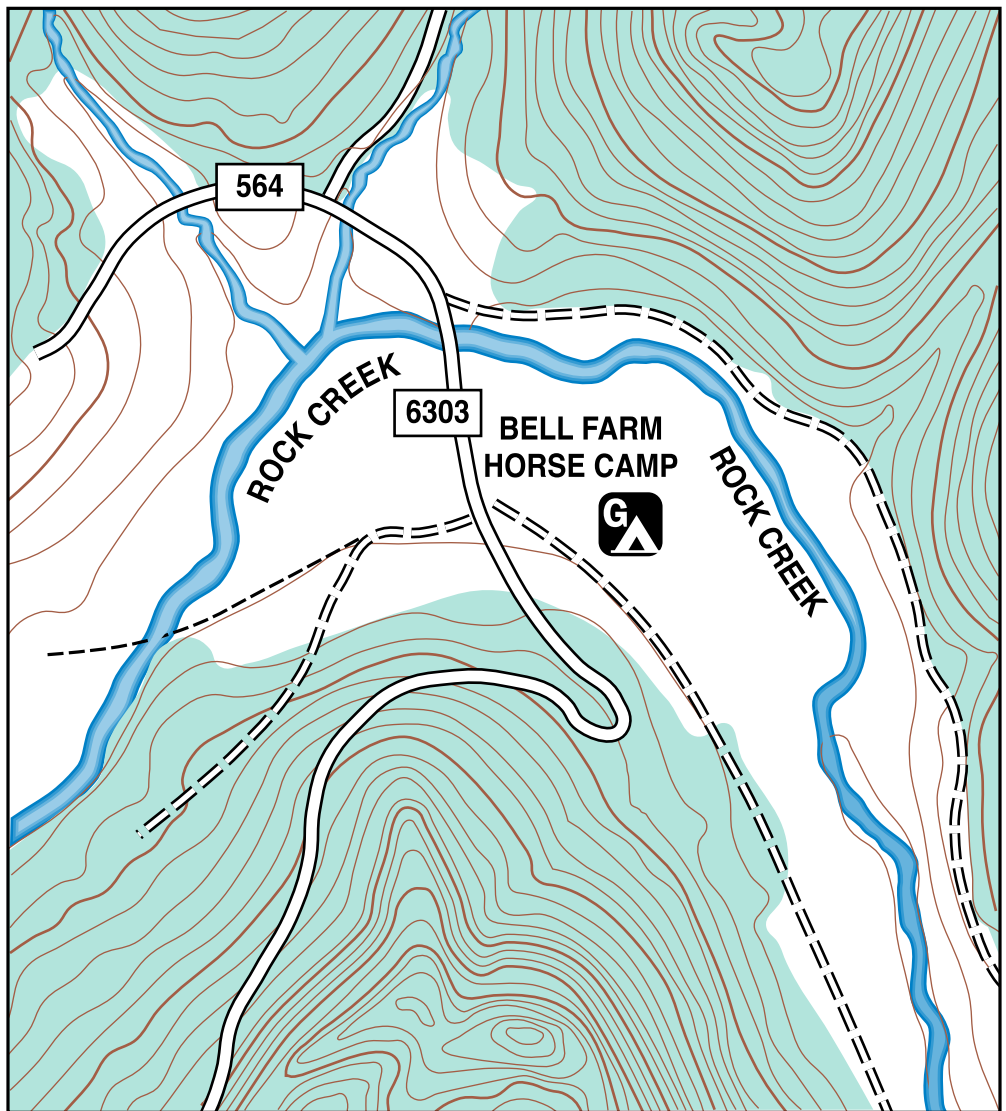


Restrictions

Closed except for campers from 11 pm to 6 am. Use hitching posts and corrals to secure horses. Do not tie horses to the trees. **Violators will be fined.**

Welcome To Bell Farm Horse Camp

The area near the horse camp was a logging and mining town in the early 1900s. During the 1930s, a Civilian Conservation Corps Camp was located here. The walnut trees you see here today were planted in 1953. Rock Creek, designated a Kentucky Wild River, runs along the camp, and is stocked with rainbow and brown trout year round. This camp is a popular place for wagon train riders from Tennessee to rest.

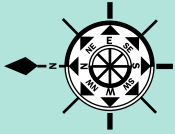
