Directions: From I-26, take exit 60 (SC 66) southwest for 3.5 miles. Turn right onto FS Road 358 and drive 0.3 mile. From Whitmire take SC Route 66 southwest for 6.2 miles to Forest Service Road 358; turn left (south) and drive for 0.3 mile.

Facilities:

- 23 campsites with tables, grills, and lantern holders
- Restrooms
- **Extended Stay Designated Campsites:** 9, 12, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, and 23 – all other sites have a 14-day stay limit.

Fees: \$5/night

\$50/30-day period, September – December, April

\$150/Season, September – December

Safety: Care should be taken in the woods during big-game season. Wear blaze orange.

Season: year-round

Regulations: South Carolina fishing and hunting license and regulations apply on all National Forest land. Horses are allowed in designated area only.

Reservations: Not accepted. All sites are first-come, first served.
