National Forests in Mississippi Land and Resource Management Plan

Amendment Number 12

This amendment changes the acreage allocations shown on page 4-95 of the Forest Plan to reflect the total acres allocated to the Not Suitable 2 management prescription as a result of establishing a Task Force Maneuver Area as described in the Record of Decision for Authorization of Military Training Use of National Forest Lands Camp Shelby, Mississippi.

The acreage shown depicts the total acres allocated for Tank Maneuver Areas, the Dedicated Impact Area and Buffer, and a new category "Other Areas" which includes the Firing Points, Range Facilities, and Bullet Contaminated Areas. The Keesler Rifle Range and Buffer acreage was not affected by this decision and remains unchanged.

The change shown for the Impact Area and Buffer reflects a correction to the acreage shown and not a change in allocation. The actual change in allocation from current management is 4,370 acres. These are additional acres allocated to the Not Suitable 2 prescription as a result of authorizing the reconfiguration of existing Track Maneuver Areas to establish the Task Force Maneuver Area.
