

Hunting Information

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The Ouachita National Forest Walk-In Turkey Hunting Areas are a joint partnership between the USDA Forest Service, Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, and the Arkansas Wild Turkey Federation as a part of the Making Tracks program. It began in 1989 as a way to improve wild turkey habitat on national forest lands. It is also designed to provide a surplus of wild turkeys for stocking and introducing into suitable areas throughout the nation.

State Regulations

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SHARPTOP MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA is located on the Caddo Ranger District of the Ouachita National Forest. The area, which contains 11,275 acres, is seven miles north of Glenwood, Arkansas.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), forest roads 863, 120, C-44, C-52, 589 and C-32 are closed to motor vehicle traffic from February 1 to September 1 of each year. Forest roads C-31, C-35 and C-42 have been developed into wildlife food plots and will remain closed year-round.

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



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LEADER MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY

HUNTING AREA is 9,925 acres in size and located between Shady Lake Recreation Area and the Albert Pike Recreation Area on the Caddo Ranger District of the Ouachita National Forest.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), forest road B18 is closed year-round and roads B30A, B29, 914, B05 and B05A are closed to motor vehicle traffic from February 1 to September 1 of each year.

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HOGAN MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA

is located directly southwest of Dry Creek Wilderness. It provides 7,800 acres of quality hunting for the turkey hunter in Scott and Logan counties.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), the following forest roads are closed year-round:

- 285 from mile point 0.2 to end
- 286 from mile point 2.1 to end
- 635 from mile point 0.2 to end
- 875 from mile point 1.7 to end

All roads are used during timber sales and other administrative activities.

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

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FOURCHE MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA is 3,162 acres and located about 3.5 miles south of Rover, Arkansas in Yell County.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), forest roads 665, 96B and F77C have been developed into wildlife food plots and will remain closed year-round, except during the modern weapons deer season.

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

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DECKARD MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY

HUNTING AREA provides 7,400 acres of quality hunting in Garland and Perry counties. It is located six miles north of Jessieville, Arkansas, or 12 miles south of Fourche Junction on Highway 7.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), all forest developed roads in the area are closed to motor vehicle traffic year-round.

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



Deckard Mountain Walk-In Turkey Hunting Area

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SHUT-IN MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY

HUNTING AREA is 8,400 acres and located about 9 miles north of Mena, Arkansas in Scott County.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), forest roads M31, M1A, M-22, and portions of 49A and M24 are closed to motor vehicle traffic year-round, except during timber sales and other administrative activities. The development plan for this area specifies that the majority of these roads will be seeded into wildlife food plots and will remain closed. Foot and horse travel are allowed throughout the walk-in area.

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CHINQUAPIN MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA is 12 miles south of Perryville, Arkansas, or three-fourths of a mile south of Williams Junction on Highway 9. The 8,011-acre area in Perry and Saline Counties provides a quality recreational experience for turkey hunters.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), all forest developed roads in the area are closed to motor vehicle traffic year-round.

The Ouachita National Forest prohibits off-road vehicle use in the area and also has implemented penalties for violations of the regulations. Violation of the prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e), persons with a permit from the U.S. Forest Service specifically authorizing an otherwise prohibited act are exempt from the order, along with federal, state or local law enforcement, firefighting or rescue officers acting in an official capacity.



Hunting Information

Hunters will find several quality walk-in turkey hunting areas within the 1.8 million acres on the Ouachita National Forest. These areas are the result of hunters requesting opportunities to hunt on public lands managed by the USDA Forest Service in a place free of disturbance from motor vehicles.

The Ouachita (pronounced Wash-I-tah) Mountains have seen the number of hunters increase dramatically during the last 20 years, making it challenging for serious turkey hunters to find an area to hunt away from traffic and noise.

All maintained roads leading into each area are closed to motor vehicle traffic from early spring to late summer. In some areas, road segments and primitive forest roads are permanently closed and re-vegetated to improve turkey habitat and to control erosion. Signs are posted along the boundaries of each area to inform the public about motor vehicle restrictions. Restricting vehicle traffic protects turkeys during the critical nesting and brood rearing seasons. Other habitat improvements include prescribed burning and establishing water holes and food plots for the turkeys. These same projects will improve the habitat for more than 100 other species of wildlife.

The Ouachita National Forest Walk-In Turkey Hunting Areas are a joint partnership between the USDA Forest Service, Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation, and the National Wild Turkey Federation as a part of the Making Tracks program. It began in 1989 as a way to improve wild turkey habitat on national forest lands. It is also designed to provide a surplus of wild turkeys for stocking and introducing into suitable areas throughout the nation.

State Regulations

Hunting is permitted anywhere on the Ouachita National Forest except within developed recreation sites or otherwise posted areas. All state hunting and fishing regulations, fees, and seasons apply on national forest land. BLUE MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA

is located on the south side of Blue Mountain in Holson Valley.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), forest development roads A32, A31A and A23B are closed year-round.

For your safety, the Ouachita National Forest prohibits off-road vehicle use in the area and also has implemented penalties for violations of the regulations. Violation of the prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.

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

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

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State Regulations

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WELL HOLLOW MOUNTAIN WALK-IN TURKEY HUNTING AREA is located in Holson Valley. It provides 2,500 acres of quality recreational experiences for the turkey hunter.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) and (b), forest development road A38 is closed year-round. Roads A38A and A41D are closed from February 1 to July 31 each year.

For your safety, the Ouachita National Forest prohibits off-road vehicle use in the area and also has implemented penalties for violations of the regulations. Violation of the prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. 261.50(e), persons with a permit from the U.S. Forest Service specifically authorizing an otherwise prohibited act are exempt from the order, along with federal, state or local law enforcement, firefighting or rescue officers acting in an official capacity.
