




Employment Opportunity

The **Allegheny National Forest (ANF)** in northwestern Pennsylvania is seeking detailers and other candidates who will work in a team to accomplish field work, data management and analysis, report writing and administration of current oil and gas developments on the Forest.

The ANF is headquartered in the town of Warren, Pennsylvania with two ranger districts in Marienville and Marshburg, PA. The 513,000-acre forest is the only National Forest in Pennsylvania and lies within a day's drive of 1/3 of the Nation's population. It includes 2 Wilderness areas, 2 National Scenic Areas, 2 National Wild and Scenic Rivers, and the Tionesta Research Natural Area (the largest contiguous tract of old growth forest in Pennsylvania).



There is a range of opportunities available in areas such as: archeology, botany, geology, GIS, hydrology/soils/aquatics, OGM (Oil, Gas, Minerals) administration, recreation/visuals/socio-economics, team leadership, transportation/roads, wildlife/fisheries, and writing/editing.

The ANF will be filling these temporary, full-time positions to start in April/May of 2009 not to exceed May of 2010.
