## **BRADFORD RANGER DISTRICT REQUESTS PUBLIC COMMENTS ON UPPER KINZUA PROJECT, MCKEAN COUNTY**

*Bradford, Pa.* – Bradford District Ranger Anthony Scardina requests public comments on the Upper Kinzua project proposal, which lies east of Kinzua Bay on the Allegheny Reservoir and covers 28,221 acres in the following townships: Hamilton, Hamlin, Lafayette, and Wetmore.

The Upper Kinzua Project covers 27,512 acres of public lands and includes proposals for vegetation management; prescribed fire; wildlife improvement and habitat restoration; stream improvements and restoration to benefit Kinzua Creek; road construction, maintenance, and decommissioning; and other resource activities.
