Blueberry Patch Campground

Caring for the Land and Serving People

Description:

Blueberry Patch Campground is a small, semi-primitive campground located along Picnic Area Road (County Route 2), next to the large blueberry patch for which it is named. This is a popular spot to gather berries when they are in season. The berry patch features high bush as well as low bush blueberries. The campground gate is open from May through October 31st. From late fall to early spring you may walk in and camp. Sites are available on a first come-first served basis. There is a \$10.00 per site per night camping fee.

Facilities:

Campground: There are nine campsites available on a first come-first served basis. Each has a fire pit, a place to park, and a picnic table. Some the picnic tables are handicap accessible. There are two handicap accessible vault toilets. This campground is best suited for tents or small campers. Dumpster service is provided from May to October 31st. **There is no drinking water available.** A campground host is usually provided at this recreation site. We rely on volunteers to staff this summer position.

Day Use Area: There is a parking lot as you drive into the campground. If you prefer to hike, picnic, or gather berries without camping, you may park your car here.



Directions:

From the South, take State Route 14 North (Exit 52 off State Route 17) to Watkins Glen, NY. In Watkins Glen, turn right at the Fourth St intersection onto State Route 414 North. Go approximately 9 miles north, past the Hector Ranger Station of the Finger Lakes National Forest. 0.5 miles past the Ranger Station, turn right on Schuyler County Route 2. Travel for 4.0 miles east. Blueberry Patch Campground is on the right.

From the North, take State Route 414 South to Hector, NY (Exit 41 off I-90). In Hector, 0.5 miles past Wickham's Plaza, turn left onto County Route 2, the second asphalt road on the left. Travel for 4.0 miles east. Blueberry Patch Campground is on the right.

Notes:

- Maximum length of stay is 14 days
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- Check out time is 2:00 PM
- There is no dump station

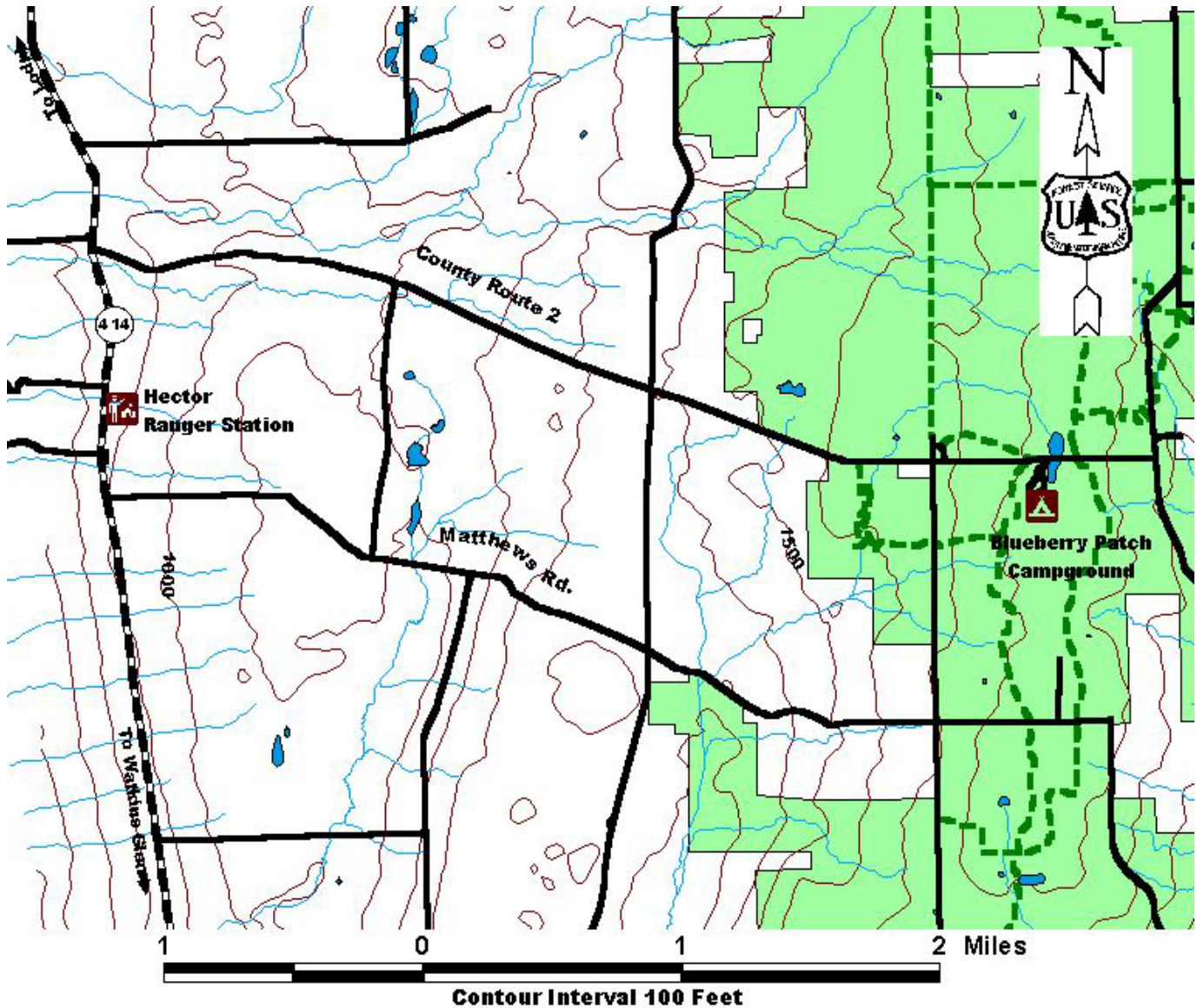
