Albany Covered Bridge Closure

The State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation (DOT) in cooperation with the Town of Albany and the White Mountain National Forest will be performing maintenance activities on the Albany Covered Bridge beginning Monday, November 16, 2009. To safely perform this maintenance the Albany Covered Bridge and the Covered Bridge parking area will be closed to all pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular traffic for the duration of the project. The bridge, which spans the Swift River, is located approximately 6 miles west of Conway, NH and serves to connect the Passaconaway (Dugway) Road and the Kancamagus Scenic Byway (NH 112).

All visitors will be asked to make alternate plans when visiting Albany Covered Bridge, the Nanamocomuck Ski Trail, or the Boulder Loop Trail. The Boulder Loop trailhead will remain open and may be accessed from the Passaconaway (Dugway) Road in the snow-free season. There are a number of alternate entry points for the Nanamocomuck Ski Trail located on the Kancamagus Highway.
