The White Mountain National Forest is planning to fill a seasonal temporary position at the Pemigewasset Ranger District in the community of Plymouth, NH.

Interested applicants **MUST** apply through the AVUE Digital Services, an on-line application process, in order to be considered for the position. Hiring actions will commence after **May 17**. In order to insure that your application will be considered, please apply as soon as possible as the application process can be time consuming. See hiring instructions below.

Lead Forestry Technician (Timber Sale Preparation) - Performs timber sales preparation duties, such as cruising timber, in support of timber sales activities.

Serves as a team/work leader, leading team efforts in the development, implementation, and/or evaluation of program or project responsibilities. Facilitates team or unit processes by working with team members or employees to ensure that tasks are completed, that good working relationships among team members and with management officials are maintained, and that team priorities and goals, needs, and achievements are coordinated with management.

Conducts inspections, measures and records field data, follows test and/or sampling procedures; validates data and determines its sufficiency; and notes field conditions and circumstances under which data was collected for forestry programs.

Marking timber sale boundaries and stump marking trees; collecting GPS data and performing maintenance work on gates and signs.
