### **Student Temporary Employment Program (STEP) position in Conway, NH**

The Saco Ranger District, Recreation Program is planning to fill one Student Temporary Employment Program (STEP) position in Conway, NH for the 2009 summer field season. The student hired for this position will work in all areas of the Recreation program throughout the 2009 summer season. The selected candidate should be prepared for a variety of work tasks and experiences. A positive attitude and flexible work schedule are required.

#### **Dates:**

June 1, 2009-September 1, 2009(exact dates based upon school schedule)

#### **Housing:**

Dormitory housing may be available upon request.

#### **Job Description:**

Anticipated work assignments will likely include:

- Delivering interpretive and educational programs to a variety of audiences in office and field settings.
- Performing a variety of manual labor tasks in different work settings, such as building and grounds maintenance, shops and warehouses, office buildings, front-country recreation sites and day use areas, etc.
- Cleaning bathrooms, removing trash, mowing lawns, providing visitor information and education at day use sites.
- Performing visitor information and education, maintaining sites and facilities at remote sites in backcountry and Wilderness areas.
- Performing trail maintenance and reconstruction as part of a crew. Work includes cleaning waterbars, clearing blowdowns, brushing, and blazing. Heavy reconstruction work involves quarrying and setting rocks and logs for waterbars, staircases, turnpikes, and other trail features.

The Student Temporary Employment Program is designed to provide work experience to students in any occupational field, whether or not related to the student's academic major.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

You are eligible under the Student Educational Employment Program if you are:

- A student enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a degree-seeking student (diploma, certificate, etc.)
- At least 18 years old as required by Federal, state or local laws and standards governing the employment of minors,
- Taking at least half-time academic or vocational and technical course load in an accredited high school, technical or vocational school, 2-year or 4-year college or university, graduate or professional school, and a U.S. citizen or a national (resident of American Samoa or Swains Island). Non-citizens may be eligible for employment if: permitted by a Federal agency's appropriation act, and eligible to work under U.S. immigration laws.
