White Mountain National Forest Announces Dry River Bridge Project

The Dry River Bridge, located on the White Mountain National Forest, 1.7 miles from the Dry River Trailhead on Route 302 in Crawford Notch, is scheduled to be replaced beginning November 6, 2009. During installation time, a half mile segment of trail on either side of the bridge will be temporarily closed due to construction hazards. The trail and bridge are expected to be reopened by November 25, 2009.

Visitors should anticipate that temporary closures will cause delays ranging from one hour (when transitional hazards are present) to much lengthier day long closures (when hazardous conditions are not able to be quickly abated).
