The Pemigewasset Ranger District of the White Mountain National Forest is seeking public review and comments on a 30-Day Comment Report for the Rumney Rocks Project in the town of Rumney, Grafton County, NH. The project proposal includes improving existing parking areas, constructing a new hiking trail paralleling Buffalo Road, and improving access trails to crags and some staging areas at the bases of crags.

The publication date in the Union Leader is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period. Individuals and organizations wishing to be eligible to appeal this decision must provide their name, address, comments, and signature (or other verification of identity upon request) during this 30-day comment period.
