The Cadillac-Manistee Ranger District on the Huron-Manistee National Forest has received a request for a special use permit for continued location, operation and maintenance of a telephone line National Forest System lands.

The request is for a 20-year special use permit to Kaleva Telephone Company for the continued use, operation and maintenance of telephone line.

The existing lines are located on the following National Forest System lands:

SW¹/₄, Section 31, T21N, R13W,

E¹/₂ SE¹/₄, Section 9,

NW¹/₄, NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, N¹/₂ SE¹/₄, E¹/₂ E¹/₂ NE¹/₄, Section 15,

NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 16,

Manistee County, Michigan

Total National Forest System land involved in this decision is 4.16 acres.

No new construction or disturbance beyond the existing site will be allowed by this decision.
