

Huron-Manistee National Forests
Cadillac-Manistee Ranger District Special Uses Projects

The Cadillac-Manistee Ranger District on the Huron-Manistee National Forest has received a request for a special use permit for continued location, operation and maintenance of a telecommunications tower on National Forest System lands.

The request is for a 10-year special use permit to AT & T Michigan for the continued use, operation and maintenance of telecommunication site for a private mobile radio service. The site is located in the SW¹/₄ Section 4, Township 22 North, Range 10 W, Wexford County, Michigan. No new construction or disturbance beyond the existing site will be allowed by this decision. Total National Forest System land involved in this decision is 3.7 acres.
