Udell Rollways Campground is located on the Manistee River, which has been designated as a wild and scenic river. The scenery is beautiful during all seasons, but especially vibrant with fall colors. Due to the steep banks, there is no easy access to the river.

LOCATION

Udell Rollways is located in Manistee County, Michigan. The nearest community is Wellston, about 8 miles southeast.

NATIONAL FOREST ACCESS CAMPGROUND

From the junction of US-31 and M-55 in Manistee, go east on M-55 approximately 12 miles. Turn north on Horseshoe Bend Road for 2 miles to the site.


From Wellston (M-55), go west approximately 7 miles. Turn north on Horseshoe Bend Road for 2 miles to the site.

FACILITIES AVAILABLE

- 23 Graveled parking spurs
- 1 Vault toilet building
- 23 Fire rings

SEASON

The managed season is from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. The campground remains open year round, unless closed by snowfall. Please check with the Manistee Ranger Station regarding dates outside the managed season (231-723-2211 or TTY 231-723-0124).



FEES

For the latest information regarding camping fees and condition of the facility, contact the Manistee Ranger District at (231) 723-2211 or (231) 723-0124 TTY. No reservations may be made for the campsites. This campground is operated by a concessionaire. A day use fee is required, see campground bulletin board for pricing information.

CONSIDERATIONS

Climbing of the bank is not advised because of safety and erosion concerns.

To avoid resource damage, camping is allowed at designated sites only.

Care should be taken to keep the area clean and in the condition it was found, so visitors are asked to please pack out what they pack in.
