With easy access, Loon Lake Picnic Area provides both picnicking and swimming opportunities for day use. Nestled mostly in National Forest land, Loon Lake provides a wide variety of wildlife and opportunities for recreation. There is an ample swimming beach; however, there is no boat launch.

## LOCATION

The Loon Lake Recreation Area is located in Oscoda County, Michigan. The nearest communities are Rose City, about 7 miles south and Mio, about 10 miles north.

## ACCESS


South from Mio or north from Rose City, turn west from M-33 onto County Road 486 approximately 1/4 mile. Turn right on Forest Service Road 4228 about 1/4 mile to the area.
