




# South Branch Trail Camp

South Branch Trail Camp serves the 240-mile cross state Michigan Shore-to-Shore Horseback Riding and Hiking Trail. The camp primarily serves campers with horses using the trail system, however, everyone is welcome. South Branch Trail Camp is adjacent to the South Branch River, which contains brown trout and is within 1.5 miles of Loud Dam Pond on the AuSable River. There are many places for horses to rest and for campers to recreate.



## LOCATION

South Branch Trail Camp is located in Iosco County, Michigan. The nearest communities are South Branch, about 5 miles to the west, and Hale, about 10 miles south.

## ACCESS

From the south, follow M-65 north of Hale. Turn on Rollway Road and follow for 3 miles to the campground entrance.

From the west, take M-55 to M-65 and go north 13.5 miles to Rollway Road and travel 3 miles to the campground entrance.

## SEASON

The season is from Memorial Day through October 30. However, the area may be opened earlier and/or closed later depending on use.
