

FY 2014 USDA Forest Service Budget Justification Errata

The FY 2014 Budget Justification posted on the Forest Service website contains the following errata. The update is for the Forest Legacy Program FY 2014 Project List. Projects are selected through an annual competitive selection process. When the FY 2014 project selection process that developed the FY 2014 project list was underway, funding for FY 2013 program had not been resolved. When FY 2013 funding was resolved, some projects on both lists were fully funded in FY 2013 and some projects on both lists were partially funded in FY 2013. Removing the fully funded projects from the FY 2014 list and adjusting downward the partially funded projects allowed increases in recommended funding levels for some projects and allowed for additional projects to the list. The following adjustments have been made to account for projects funded in FY 2013 to the FY 2014 Forest Legacy Program Proposed Projects.

- The following three projects, Blood Run National Historic Landmark Area, Gilchrist Forest, and Munger Mountain Corridor, were fully funded in FY 2013 and have been removed from the FY 2014 Forest Legacy Program Proposed Projects listed in the FY 2014 Budget Justification.
- Two projects, Pascagoula River Conservation Lands and Quabbin Reservoir to Wachusett Mountain, were partially funded and the amount of the Request was reduced in FY 2014.
- For four projects, Klickitat Canyon Working Forest, Paulding County Land Area, Liberty Hill Phase I, and Thorpe Mountain, funding was increased.
- The following eight projects, Little Smokies, Discovery Woods, Mobile Tensaw Delta, Rensselaer Plateau Working Forest, Wild Waters, West Klamath Lake Forest, Zion North Fork, and Oliverian Valley, have been added at the bottom of the list to allocate all of the requested funds.
