

IBS Release notes for Ver. 1.2.3

This is the synopsis of the new and corrected functionality included in version 1.2.3. The primary objective for this release is to correct errors in the program and update lists.

New Version Access

Clear Cache in Google Chrome, see handout for instructions.

Type in the URL, do not use favorites or copy past. URL: www.apps.fs.usda.gov/ibs

Fixes

- Airport names longer than 50 characters will no longer give an error messages.
- Error messages will disappear and not hold over when you reopen "Additional Charges".
- Calendar Icon on "Create Invoice" screen is operational, you can click on the white space or the icon to pick a date. (Do not type in a date, as that will not active the link to EAV to pick up contract information)
- Emails will be going out again, COR to Vendor, Vendor back to COR, COR to ASC
- Vendors names will appear in the correct location after they approve the invoices
- Vendors are able to edit invoice and input remarks before returning it back to the COR for corrections.

Changes

An error message will appear if a second "Availability" leg is entered.

When entering "Add Additional Charges" when complete, a "Wait saving" message appears so you will not click "Add" twice.

Updates

On WCF aircraft the pilot drop down pick list has been updated. Pilot's names that no longer fly for us have been hidden not removed to save legacy data.

The Mission Code list has been cleaned up. Though we could not hide outdated codes, till next version. Please pick correct codes. Working on getting only certain codes to show for certain aircraft; so an airtanker cannot do PSD work.

User Code list has been updated so only the new unit codes are visible. All state names have been hidden.

New items:

- Incompatibility Message on all browser, except Google Chrome.
