Summary Description

Purpose/Need
The purpose and need for this project is to prevent sedimentation of reservoirs and impacts to the water quality by addressing run-off and erosion on slopes and streams above the reservoirs. Reservoirs covered by this project include the Chambers, Peterson, Hourglass, Barnes Meadow, and Comanche Reservoirs.
Intended Selected Action
36 CFR 220.6(e)(11) – Authorization of post-fire treatments on NFS lands adjacent to five reservoirs affected by the Cameron Peak fire. Project proponent is City of Greely. Proposal includes wattles and mulching. The project will cover approximately 20 acres.
Potentially Significant Effects or Extraordinary Circumstances (if any)
IDT review scheduled for 2/16/2021 when extraordinary circumstances will be reviewed. A Minimum Requirements Analysis (MRA) for wilderness will be conducted prior to reaching a decision.
Public Involvement (include State, local governments and Tribal consultation)
Public involvement for this CE decision includes coordinating with local partners during fire recovery efforts as well as posting the project to SOPA and forest website.
