Summary Description

Purpose/Need
This project is needed to restore the forest ecosystem and reduce fuel loadings on the Gallinas Unit of the Mountainair District. The treatments are needed to reduce the potential of uncharacteristic wildfires to protect the Community of Corona.

Approximately 3,000 acres of thinning and mastication.

Public scoping and collaboration occurred for project in 2019. A scoping letter was mailed to project mailing including local government, cooperators, adjacent landowners, and congressionals. Unique letters were sent to tribal representatives including Isleta, Mescalero, and Navajo.
